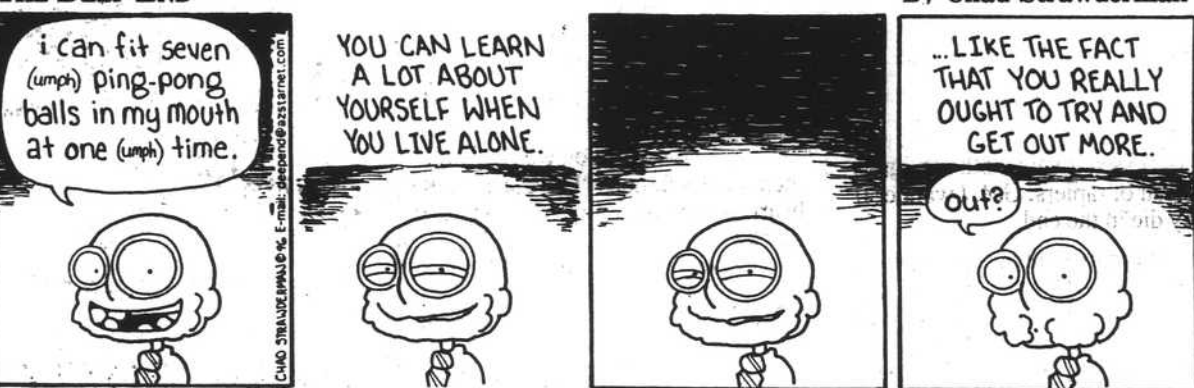

## Doug Bereuter

1. He is a Phi Beta Kappa graduate of UNL and a supportive alumnus.
2. In his congressional role, he has been actively supportive of a wide range of construction, research and educational programs and projects at UNL.
3. As a state senator, he conceived and initiated a four-year undergraduate education improvement program which added 40-plus "Bereuter professors" at UNL and started the undergraduate teaching awards at UNL.
4. Served as a part-time associate professor at UNL for several years.

#### UNL students should know that Doug Bereuter:

- was an original co-sponsor on the legislation that created Americorps, the domestic "Peace Corps," where students perform public service in return for an education stipend to be used for post-secondary education.
- was an active participant in the creation and implementation of a system of direct student loans.
- was a long-time supporter of changing the need formula for financial aid so that a family farm or home is no longer considered when determining financial need for students applying for aid.
- voted in support of legislation to make the interest on student loans tax deductible and to allow penalty free withdrawal from IRAs to pay for higher education expenses. **Unfortunately, President vetoed this legislation.**
- voted to increase the maximum Pell grant award by 15 percent to \$2700 — an all-time high.
- voted to increase funding for the Work Study program by 34 percent to \$830 million — an all-time high.
- voted to increase funding for TRIO programs by 7.9 percent to \$500 million — an all-time high.

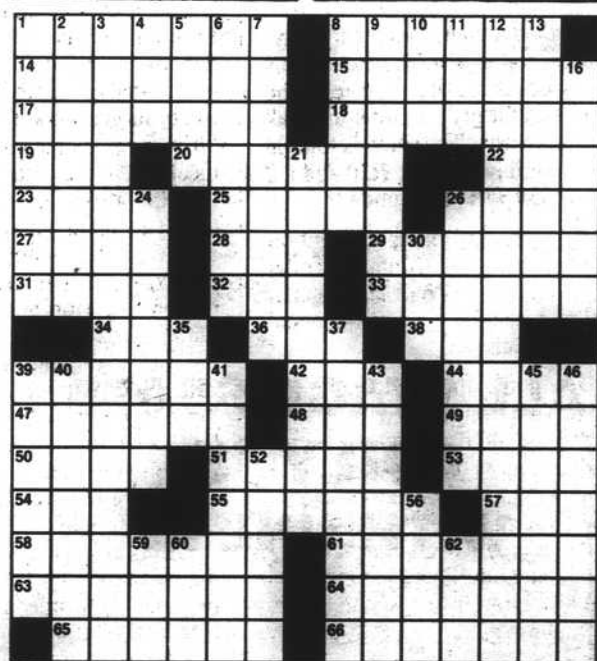

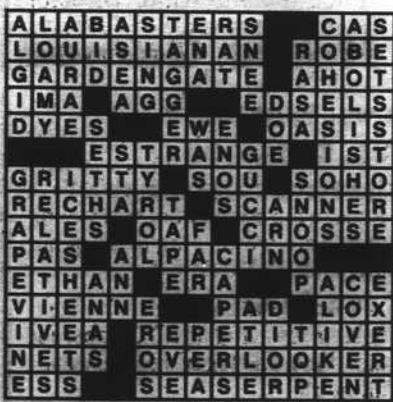
