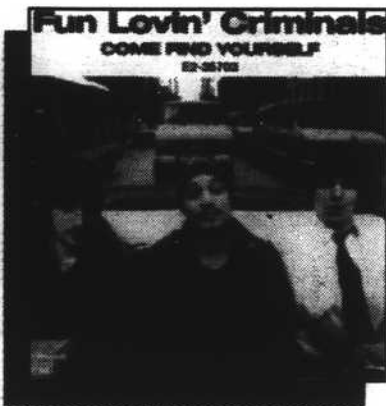

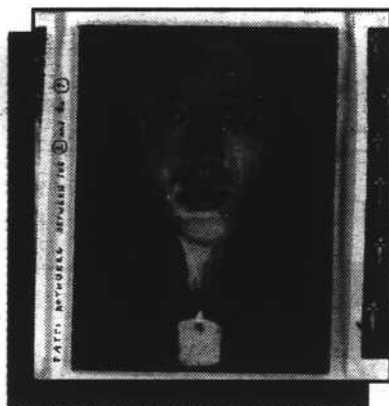


FUN LOVIN' CRIMINALS

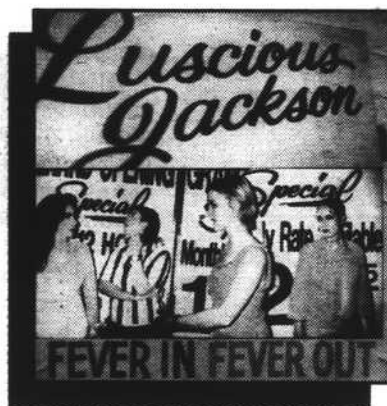


PATTI ROTHBERG

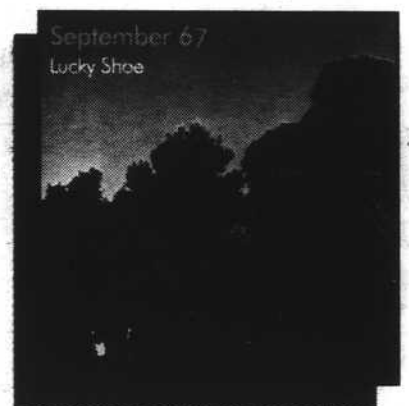


LUSCIOUS JACKSON
