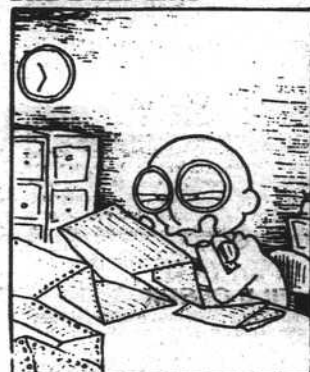

Editor In Chief

The Daily Nebraskan is now taking applications for next year's editor in chief. The editor formulates editorial policy, determines guidelines for the daily operation of the newsroom, hires the senior editorial staff, helps determine the content of the editorial page and prepares the editorial salary budget. Applicants must have one year experience, preferably at the Daily Nebraskan, be enrolled in at least 6 hours at UNL with a 2.0 minimum G.P.A. and submit clips when applying. The position begins August 1, 1997 and lasts until May 8, 1998. A half of month's salary is paid in the Spring, 1997. Salary is \$975/month (except 1/2 month in December and pro-rated in May. Applications are available at the Daily Nebraskan, 34 Nebraska Union and must be returned by 3 p.m., Friday, Jan. 17.
