Huskers beat Wayne State

Scott Schultz singled home Jason Fry in the bottom of the eighth inning to lead Nebraska to a 6-5 win in its season opener Saturday over Wayne State at Buck Beltzer Stadium.

The Cornhuskers jumped out to a 4-0 lead in the second inning against Wildcats starter Nate Corman. NU opened the inning with consecutive singles by Fry and Andrew Sawyers, before Francis Collins blasted a three-run home run. The next batter, Kevin Harrington, followed with a solo homer.

Wayne State roared back scoring

three runs in the third. With one out, Darin Gregory doubled and James Mansell followed with another double to score Gregory. Mike Vanderwelt capped the inning with a two-run blast to pull Wayne State back within 4-3.

NU padded its lead in the sixth when Collins walked, advanced to second on a wild pitch, stole third and came home when Mansell's throw sailed into left field. The Wildcats tied the game in the seventh with two runs to set up Schultz's game-winning hit.

Spence Van Linge, the ninth Husker pitcher, picked up the win after 1 1/3 innings of perfect relief. Jason Winfield (0-1) took the loss for Wayne State.
