right, it sounds really beautiful." Jazz, he said, is in everything he plays.

"I play a 12-bar thing, not just a four-five chord. My stuff has a lot of chords," he said.

Memphis Slim bestowed the nickname "Guitar" on him while Murphy was playing in his band, the House Rockers, for his innovative playing and his close relationship with his instrument.

"I still sleep with my guitar," he admitted. "I'm always practicing with it and when I wake up in the morning it's already there."

The bedmate of choice is a 1961 Strat, used with a Boogie Amp given to him by John Belushi.

After playing for many Chess Recording artists, including Muddy Wa-

ters, Howlin' Wolf and Sonnyboy Williamson, and cutting records with many other stars, Murphy was "discovered" by Dan Aykroyd and John Belushi in New York in 1978.
