The three are caught in a web spun by Corky and Violet to steal \$2 million in mafia money, which is being held by Caesar right next door. This plan is hatched as a product of a budding lesbian affair after Violet realizes that Corky is gay. Violet asserts herself and a few rather incredible love scenes ensue.

"Bound" is both Gothic and surreal; it's sensual in its content and gripping in its ambient camera work. The musical score brilliantly paces the film, complementing subtle humor with jazz and stretching suspense with laboring strings.
