LOS ANGELES (AP) — The man hired to he fulfilled his promise of more patrols in the 20 percent and complaints against officers iams he could be fired if he didn't improve his changes ranging from officer discipline and the use of force to community policing.

Commission members, who are appointed by the mayor, have until April 7 to render their decision, but could make a determination as early as this week. Regardless, the City Council has the final say. Williams' term ends July

His lawyers have already drafted a lawsuit claim they plan to file if Williams isn't given a second term, but they have offered to withdraw it for \$3 million, the Los Angeles Times reported Friday.

The claim alleges the commission used the wrong standards to evaluate Williams' performance and acted with bias, the Times said. It also alleges he was unable to properly do his job because of political pressure from Riordan.
