for his right to be profane — at the risk of losing everything he worked for.

The film moves quickly, providing an impressively entertaining narration and comedic style. Stern, as was hoped for, did a heck of a job being himself, as did Robin Quivers and Fred Norris. The comedic bits of Stern in the studio are obviously polished but downright hilarious.

"Private Parts" is an extremely humorous and fun film providing an enhanced pseudo-documentary of one of America's most colorful personalities. While it's hard to tell how true to life it is, "Private Parts" is one of the funniest and most enjoyable films of the new year.
