Howard Stern's new film tells of rise to radio fame

actually. The devoted friend and husband, and then the charismatic and breast-inspired radio personality.

The movie's humor is slick and typically self-degrading, documenting the many mishaps and wrong turns Stern encounters on the road to success. Frequently dodging criticism of his personality and voice, Stern stubcovers he must simply be himself to make it big.

Along the way we discover Stern is a whitey-tighty man. He suffered severe ridicule for most of his life and fought vehemently and courageously the new year.
