## Garage construction on schedule

Parking woes at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln have become as routine as the changing of the seasons, but that hasn't stopped attempts to alleviate some of the problems.

UNL's latest strike against this seemingly interminable issue is the new parking garage at 10<sup>th</sup> and T streets, which has an expected completion date of Aug. 29.

The 600-stall, four-story garage will also house the Husker Authentic shop, a Husker merchant-

disse store that will be owned and operated by the Athletic Department. Construction costs for the garage have been placed at more than \$8 million.

Despite weather delays earlier this year, the garage is still expected to be finished by its target date.

Any delays beyond that would allow the university to seek liquidative damages -- unforeseen costs -- at a rate of \$1,000 per day past the deadline.

Students and faculty will be able to use the new garage beginning Aug. 30.
