Your Humble Serpent, The Wisdom of Reuben Snake" and Bonnie Looksaway's Iron Art Wagon both focus on Nativ. American culture, but from different perspectives. Reuben Snake was a prominent Winnebago leader and activist, while Bonnie is an artist.

In stark contrast to the rural themes of the first two movies, "Blue City" and "Cause N' Defect' focus on the painful realities of urban life. "Blue City" depicts the accidental interaction of four urban people. "Cause N' Defect" is an anti-drug film that shows a young man's escape from the world of drugs.

One can see all the movies with the festival pass, or can pay for each

film individually.

The cost is \$25 for a festival pass. \$15 for students or the regular price of \$6 per movie, \$4 for students and Friends of the Mary Riepma Ross Theater. The festival runs until July
