

## Lentz Center unveils exhibit

Detailed vases, exotic costumes and a variety of ceramics are part of a new exhibit at the Lentz Center, 329 Morrill Hall. The exhibit, "Vibrant Colors and Intricate Patterns: 1996-97 Gifts to the Lentz Center for Asian Culture," features items from China, Japan, Indonesia and New Guinea.

Barbara Chapman Banks, director and curator of the Lentz Center, said the idea for the exhibit came from a gourd-shaped vase donated by John and Marguerita Fosdick. John Fosdick graduated from the University of Nebraska-Lincoln in

'We realized that the vase fit the qualities of intricate colors and patterns," Banks said.

An exhibition of items with similar qualities is the result, she said.

The Fosdicks' gourd-shaped vase is garnished with various floral designs in emerald, burgundy and other brilliant colors.

Banks said the gourd's dried fruit is believed in Eastern mythology to help free spirits from the body.


