Gallery dedication postponed

The dedication of the Robert Hillestad Textiles Gallery, originally scheduled for Oct. 26 but postponed because of weather, has been rescheduled for 7 p.m. Friday.

The ceremony will be in the Home Economics Building, Room 11, on the University of Nebraska-Lincoln East Campus. After the ceremony, Hillestad will deliver a lecture titled "My Search for the Locus of Creativity in Textiles."

Gallery viewers will be able to see "The Dance of Textiles," Hillestad's show featuring all-new work. The show runs until Dec. 5.

Tickets for the show are \$3 in advance and \$5 at the door. They can be purchased at Acacia Fraternity, Kappa Delta Sorority or in the Nebraska Union.

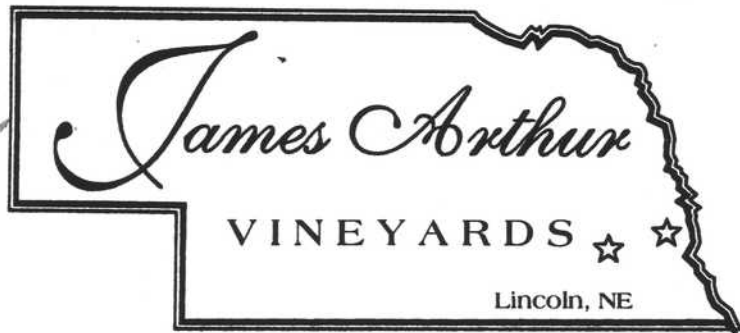
