'Audiences have shorter attention spans these days," Kolb said, "so I try to keep recitals interesting and talk a lot to my people."

Kolb, who performs between 50 and 60 recitals a year, spoke and performed to students in the School of Music Thursday afternoon. He was brought to the university by Paul Barnes, an assistant professor of piano at UNL. Barnes met Kolb in Ontario last year.

Kolb has appeared with the Chicago Symphony Orchestra and Hamburg Philharmonic, among other notable ensembles.

His performance at Carnegie Hall was hailed by The New York Times as "a piano recital program with a difference."

On Saturday, Kolb will lead a "Music and Money" workshop from 9 a.m. to noon at Southeast Community College. The seminar will focus on how musicians can be successful and find a way to make money with their talents.

Home The Concert Association is sponsoring the event. Founder and artistic adviser Ken Hauptman said this event is a must-see for all students pursuing a career in music.

'Justin has a wealth of experience because he's been there," Hauptman said. "He goes through the entire process of building a music career, step by step."

Hauptman said Kolb will cover everything at the seminar I basically show kids what they can do with a music degree on Monday mornings."


