ed in cooperation with Lewis and Susan Cuppet, who conducted the taste tests with funding from the North Dakota Oil Seed Council and the U.S. Flax Institute.

Although Omega eggs' health benefits make them appealing, their taste likely will decide whether they will succeed at the grocery store.

Scheideler said the unique fatty acids in the eggs can produce a slight "fishy taste in exceptionally tastesensitive people."

But manipulating the taste and texture of Omega eggs is "very doable," she said.

Curtis Novak, a graduate student in poultry nutrition who worked extensively on Scheideler's project, said he could not tell any difference between Omega eggs and other "normal" eggs he has eaten.

"They just taste good."
