Denver area, and met one while he was the trumpet professor at the University of Denver.

The Pretext Quartet will perform original compositions and other works as well.

White said he's particularly proud of his composition "The Tree Has Fallen (But the Roots Will Live Forever)," which was intended to honor his father, Grady White Sr.

"The Tree Has Fallen" was composed in February 1996, shortly after White's father died.

In addition, White is performing Wayne Shorter's "Footprints," Thelonious Monk's "Played Twice" and "Straight No Chaser," Fred Hamilton's "Ancient Memories" and John McNeil's "Bolero."

White's recital will be held at 8 p.m. in Kimball Recital Hall. Admission is free.

'Titanic' still tops box office charts

LOS ANGELES (AP) - "U.S. Marshals," Warner Bros.' sequel to "The Fugitive," nearly caught "Titanic" in weekend box office earnings.

Final figures released Monday by Exhibitor Relations Co. showed "Titanic," in its 12th week atop the box office charts, had weekend receipts of \$17.6 million, compared to \$16.9 million for the debut of "U.S. Marshals."

In its 12 weeks of release, "Titanic" has become the first movie in history to gross \$600 million outside North America, Daily Variety reported Monday. "Jurassic Park," the previous leader, earned \$563 million.

Until "U.S. Marshals" came along, no film had been able to come within \$1 million of "Titanic."

The maritime disaster epic has earned \$449.2 million in North America, and industry analysts expect it soon to pass "Star Wars," the all-time domestic money earner with \$461 million.

The figures can be misleading, however. The "Star Wars" figure includes its original release and re-release last year.

Inflation also skews the picture. If "Gone With the Wind" tickets were sold at today's prices, the Civil War classic would be the top earner with \$1.29 billion, Variety noted.

The next challenge to "Titanic" should come from "The Man in the Iron Mask," scheduled for release next weekend, said industry analyst David Davis, vice president of investment bankers Houlihan, Lokey, Howard & Zukin.

"Titanic" lead Leonardo DiCaprio also stars in "The Man in the Iron Mask."
