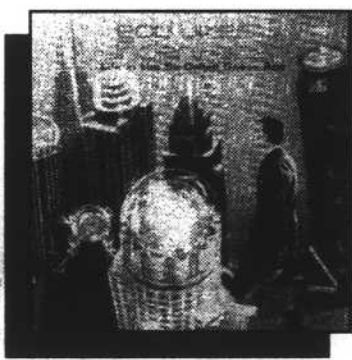
**THE SELF-RIGHTEOUS BROTHERS**

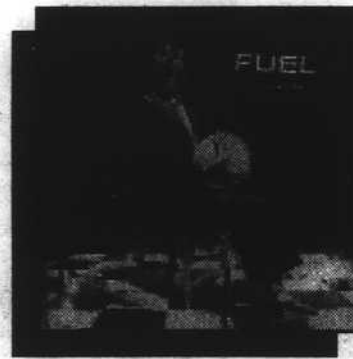
