### ABSENTEE AND DISABLED STUDENT BALLOTS

**ABSENTEE BALLOTS:** Students who will not be in Lincoln, Nebraska, during the time the polls are open will be permitted to vote by absentee ballot. Students who wish to vote by absentee ballot must complete 'Form L' (available through ASUN Director of Development between the hours of 9 am and 5 pm). Student's signature must be notarized and the ballot must be cast on or before 4 pm on Tuesday, March 10, 1998.

**DISABLED STUDENT BALLOTS:** Disabled shall mean unable to attend class due to confinement at the University Health Center or a hospital. Students so disabled shall call the ASUN Director of Development at 472-2581 on or before noon on election day, March 11, 1998, and arrangements will be made for voting.
