

# NETV to air live meeting about dreaded Y2K bug

Those who want to learn more about the Y2K bug are encouraged to participate Wednesday in a live Y2K town meeting.

John Koskinen, chairman of President Bill Clinton's Y2K Council, will join a panel of Nebraska Y2K experts who will answer questions posed by a live studio audience. The event will be broadcast on Nebraska Educational Television. People also can call in during the broadcast and ask questions.

People interested in being in the

audience should show up Wednesday at 7:30 p.m. at the Nebraska Educational Telecommunications building, 1800 N. 33rd St. Attendees are encouraged to bring questions.

The discussion, "Y2K Nebraska Town Hall," will be aired live on NETV at 8 p.m. A pre-recorded program examining the millennium bug is set for 7 p.m.

The broadcasts are sponsored in part by the Nebraska Y2K Alliance for a Confident Tomorrow, a coalition of businesses geared at providing the public with Y2K information.

## NOTICE TO STUDENTS
