Art gallery displays different art media

Unfortunately, it seems many students think of art in terms of simply paintings or sculptures.

But starting at 5 p.m. today, students at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln will get a long overdue chance to explore other media.

For the first time since its opening, the Rotunda Art Gallery, located in the northeast part of the City Campus Union, will feature an exhibition dedicated entirely to creations of mixed media.

The exhibition is part of Eddie Dominguez's special topics class, "Explorations in Mixed Media," and features the work of his students. The show has been planned since the beginning of the semester, at which time students started working on the projects to be displayed tonight.

"Within the first week of class, we all had to give a proposal," said Jennifer Helzer, a senior art major at UNL. "We had discussion time about our ideas, and we all kind of helped each other out."

Because of the nature of mixed media, an art form that ranges immensely in terms of materials, scope

and style, Dominguez's students had to work together even on seemingly simple tasks, such as mounting the works.

"We had total freedom," Helzer said. "There were only two guidelines: It had to be life-sized, and it had to be something that reflected the artist's personal interest."

The end result is a collection of creations as diverse as the people who created them. While Helzer admitted to being a bit nervous about the opening, she said it would be well worth the work.

"It's hard, because there are huge works, and it's a very limited space (in the Rotunda)," Helzer said. "But you get a chance to talk to people about your work and generate new ideas, so I'm really excited."

"Explorations in Mixed Media" opens tonight from 5 to 7 in the Rotunda. Artists will be present to discuss their work.
