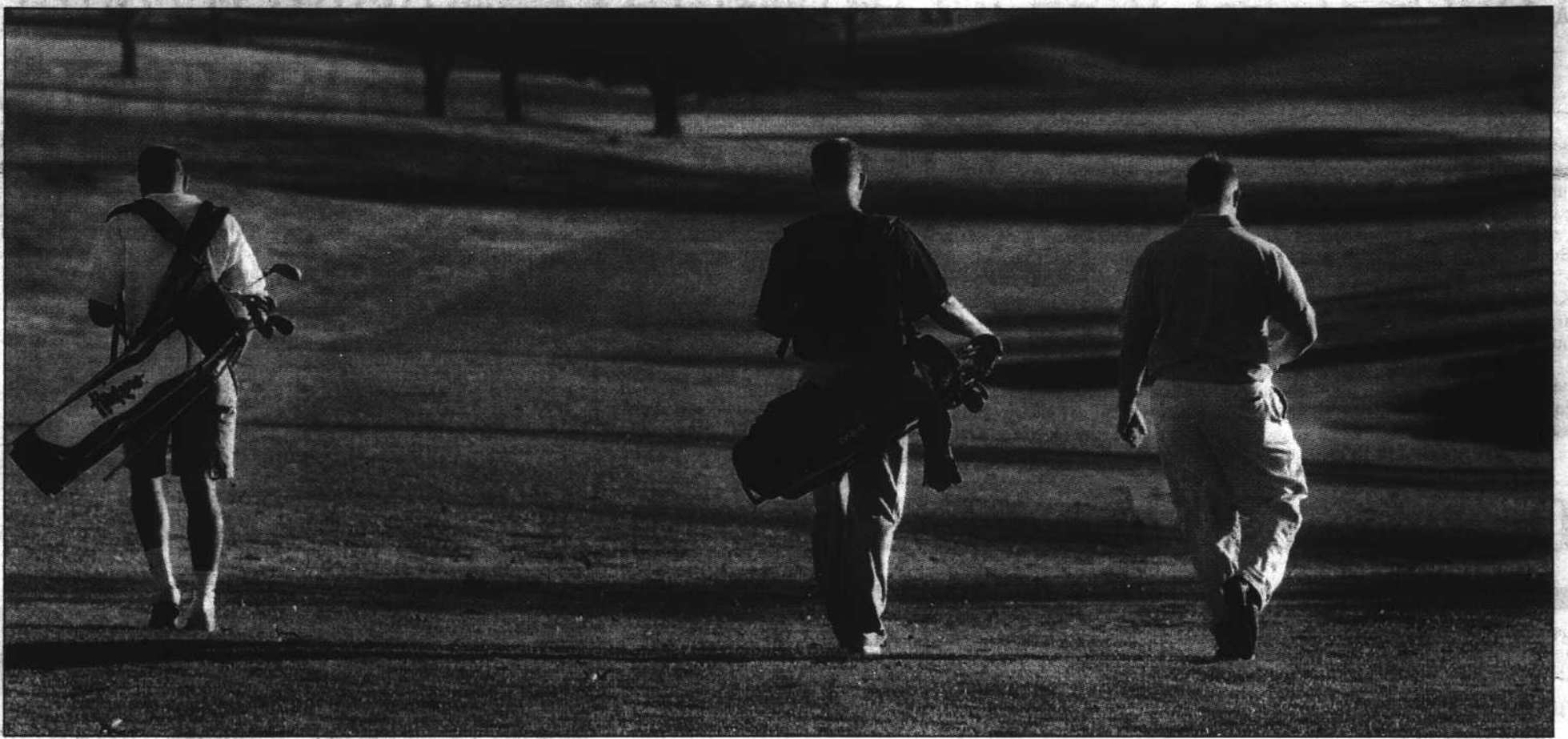


## A walk in the park

### Man drives car into hotel room; no one injured

A man drove his car into a parked car, then through a hotel wall and into a room early Sunday morning, disturbing two people asleep inside, Lincoln Police Ofc. Katherine Finnell said.

Lincoln police cited Jose Castillo, 24, for reckless driving and driving while intoxicated.

Finnell said the man was on his way back to his room at the Guesthouse Inn, 3245 Cornhusker Hwy., at about 2:10

a.m. when his 1987 brown Ford Taurus hit a green Plymouth Voyager parked in the hotel's lot.

The man then drove through one of the hotel's exterior walls and into room No. 216, Finnell said.

A man and woman sleeping inside the room were not injured, but an air conditioner mounted in a window was knocked onto the room's bed, Finnell said.

The wreck caused \$10,000 damage to the hotel. The Voyager suffered \$1,000, the Taurus \$3,000 in damages.

### Gun stolen from grocery store after break-in

Burglars took a .357 revolver from a Lincoln grocery store after breaking through the building's roof, Finnell said. Employees at the Prisa Mexican

Market, 1237 F St., reported the loss to police at 8:42 a.m. Sunday, Finnell said. The burglars pried a piece of sheet metal off the grocery store's roof, then climbed down through the ceiling, Finnell said.

The gun, valued at \$400, was the only loss reported in the incident.

### Woman finds weapons, possibly stolen, in bedroom

A woman cleaning her brother's room Sunday morning found two weapons believed to have been stolen from a Lincoln home Oct. 22, Finnell said.

While cleaning a couch in the 16-year-old's room in an apartment at 6235 Holdrege St., the woman found a .22 pistol and a Tech 9 9-mm pistol, Finnell said. Serial numbers on both

guns were scratched off. A small bag of marijuana also was found.

Police arrested the teen-ager for possession of a firearm with altered identification and possession of less than an ounce of marijuana.

Finnell said police think the guns were stolen from a home on N.W. Fairwood Court. Finnell said the ammunition clip on the Tech 9, which was full when the gun was stolen, was recovered empty.

### Student cited for marijuana possession in residence hall

University police cited an 18-year-old freshman student for possession of marijuana and drug paraphernalia early Saturday morning, University Police Sgt. Mylo Bushing said.

Police on the sixth floor of Schramm Residence Hall at 1:18 a.m. Saturday smelled marijuana smoke outside the door of 18-year-old Jeremy Turner, Bushing said.

Police talked to Turner and were given permission to search the room, Bushing said. They found two homemade smoke filters, a small metal pipe and a small amount of marijuana, Bushing said.

Police also smelled marijuana smoke on the seventh floor of Schramm at 1 a.m. Sunday but did not issue citations, Bushing said. After finding the room that appeared to be the source of the smoke, officers were unable to find marijuana or paraphernalia, Bushing said.

## Alleged rape taping leads to arrests

TIFFIN, Ohio (AP) — A football player and a wrestler at Heidelberg College were arrested and expelled from school after being accused of videotaping themselves raping an unconscious woman and then showing the tape to other students.

Students who saw the videotape went to school officials, who then called police.

Nicholas Klingler, 19, of Circleville, and Nelson Pixler, 18, of Defiance, were charged Friday with three counts of rape and released on \$60,000 bond each.

The alleged attack happened late Wednesday night and into early Thursday morning, detective Ron Green said. The videotape was found in a police search later that day, he said.

The victim, an 18-year-old Bowling Green State University student, was visiting friends on campus and didn't know the two men, police said. She told police that she had been drinking at a party and went into a friend's room to sleep.

"She doesn't remember anything," police Lt. Michelle Craig said Monday.

The victim told police that she did not consent to any sexual activity.

Police said they were investigating whether any others were involved or knew about the alleged rape but would not discuss any other details.
