Huskers seal big win over MU

Nebraska wrestlers used wins in seven of nine weight classes and a forfeit in another to blow past Missouri 32-6 in-the annual "home away from home" dual with Missouri.

Four of the Cornhuskers' seven wins were major decisions or technical falls, and Missouri failed to place a wrestler at 125-pounds opposite Joe Malia, earning NU six points.

The dual's highlight match was in the 174-pound division, where MU's No. 15 John Kopinksy outlasted Ati Conner, 4-3, earning the Tigers three of

their six points for the dual.

Conner took an early 2-0 lead in the match when he took Kopinsky down with 1:55 left in the first period. The third period started with the wrestlers tied at three, but after a Kopinsky escape, Conner didn't score any more points, and Kopinsky won the match.

Nebraska's Joe Henson won the only match featuring two rated opponents. The 15th-ranked Henson earned a 8-3 decision over Missouri's Jeff Urban, No. 19 at 149 pounds.
