McMeen said. "When you are in this market, you have to think about getting them in the door. It's hard to do that if you are depending on nice weather."

He said the closing of the largest beer garden wouldn't affect the size of the Duffy's beer garden. He said there were no immediate plans to expand.

McMeen said the competition on O Street is tight, and each bar has to do what it can to survive.

"It had to be a tough decision, because people really like the beer garden," he said. "It's sad."

Mausbach said he's received some feedback from bar patrons regarding the renovations.

"Close regulars that come in all the time have expressed great disappointment (that the beer garden will close)," he said.

But, Mausbach said, the history and aura the Rail has will be kept intact throughout the renovation process.

"We plan to keep the bar the same," he said. "The architecture and the rustic look of a college hangout will be preserved."
