Mausbach said he's received some feedback from bar patrons regarding the renovations.

'Close regulars that come in all the time have expressed great disappointment (that the beer garden will close)," he said.

But, Mausbach said, the history and aura the Rail has will be kept intact throughout the renovation

"We plan to keep the bar the same," he said. "The architecture and the rustic look of a college hangout will be preserved."
