

Municipal band, jazz night offer musical fix for Lincoln

Arts Incorporated, a non-profit Lincoln organization designed to bring local artists together, has a summer concert schedule that just might fix your musical jones.

Beginning July 2, and continuing each Sunday until August 27, the Lincoln Municipal Band will begin their summer concert season at Schildneck Bandshell in Antelope Park.

The band will feature a different theme and a rotation of local musicians and vocalists at each concert, according to Geoffrey Lear, the group's manager. In addition, guest conductors will take turns directing the 34-member band.


