A Nigerian refugee was charged with manslaughter Tuesday in the death of a Firth woman watching the Americruise hot rods last weekend.

Jarmusch film hits mark, 'In Crowd' misses

Now, after Ghost Dog accidentally kills one of the mafia's own, the "boss" is quite upset. He wants to kill the best thing they've got: Ghost Dog, the most excellent hit man.

It seems the mafia's life circles around dying and dealing with the consequences and in "Ghost Dog", Jarmusch makes mob life seem uncool and worthless unlike most other mob flicks where they are the supreme icon of power and money (i.e. making them cool).

There is an intriguing subtext involving vintage cartoons as action takes place on the screen..

The viewer gets a glimpse of the immediate past or future from a character who is watching a cartoon in an odd twist on reality. The cartoon shows what is going to happen (or has happened) in the real screen life of Ghost Dog and company.

Though I did not like this film as much as Jarmusch's last, "Dead Man", it was quite well written but not so beautifully acted. Whitaker does all right, as do the others on screen, but none shine too bright.

However, this does not stop the film from reeking with uniqueness and showing a flavor that is not too often seen on the screen. ★★1/2 *Karen Brown*
