## Deadbeat landlords may be added to guides

Students seeking off-campus housing can face several challenges, including finding a good landlord and deciphering the lease.

But one task usually outweighs the others: trying to not get ripped off.

To give students more help in making their housing choices, the student senate is revamping the off-campus housing guide provided by Commuter Services.

Right now, the guide offers a listing of available off-campus housing, which is updated weekly.

But the new guide will be more comprehensive, with information about starting and ending a lease, tenant rights and utilities service, said Joel Schafer, president of the Association of Students of the University of Nebraska.

Schafer said he hopes the new edition will be ready in February. Another possible addition to
