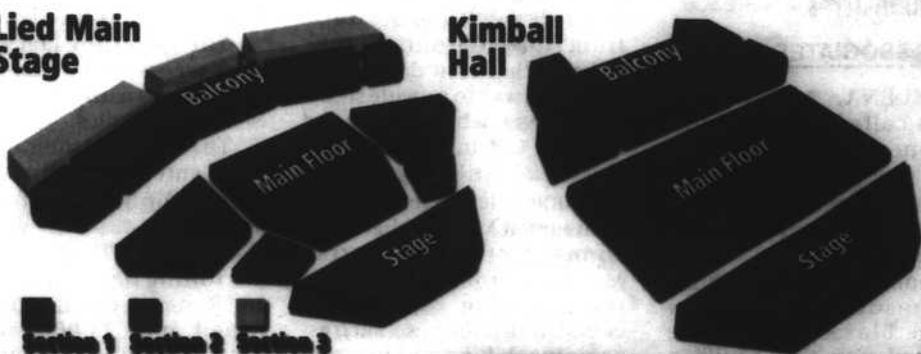


Announcing the 2000/2001 Lied Center Season!
