# **Convicted murderer** must keep sentence

**U.S. District Judge Richard** G. Kopf ruled last week that convicted death-row inmate Michael Ryan will not be eligible for resentencing by a jury.

Ryan was convicted and sentenced to death by a trial judge in 1986 after murdering James Thimm near Rulo in 1985. He contested the decision, saying a jury, not a judge, should have made the final sentencing.

Ryan was the leader of a cult in Rulo and, along with fellow cult members, tortured member Thimm for several days before murdering him.


The appeal was based on a June U.S. Supreme Court ruling that called for jury hearings to be utilized in the event of a possible increase of defendants' maximum punishments, but that case did not involve the death penalty.

Nebraska law, though, states capital punishment as the highest penalty possible for convicted murderers.

Ryan argued that the jury, not a judge, should have weighed the circumstances of
