
Moreover, he said, what would be truly unethical would be to abandon the valuable material.


"Once an abortion is performed, it is a moral sin to discard tissue that could otherwise offer hope to millions who suffer from debilitating diseases," he


While Pedersen said his bill would expedite the process of finding an alternative to aborted fetal tissue, Miller said it would cripple it.
