

A fire that started in a home late Friday night or early Saturday morning left police with no suspects.

Lincoln Police Officer Katherine Finnell said between 7 p.m. Friday and 3 a.m. Saturday, someone entered the attached garage of a home on Northwest 55th Street and tried to set the east wall of the garage on fire.

The wall did not start on fire, so the arsonist then lit the south wall on fire, causing about \$1,500 in damage to the garage and its contents, Finnell said.

Finnell said the residents, who were home at the time, smelled smoke and called the police.

Upon investigation, it was discovered that an eight-inch frozen pizza, valued at \$2.50, was also taken from the garage freezer.

Mylo Bushing, assistant university police chief, said around 4 a.m., a Community Service Officer smelled something burning in the north stairwell of Abel Hall.


Another person also reported a burning smell to the Abel front desk, Bushing said.




