"Newspapers are different than any other business because you can't make a prediction about how much advertising money you'll make every month," he said.

Next year, the newspaper will have more competition for advertisers, Willbanks said. This is because the residence halls will be offering three newspapers to dorm residents for a fee that is included in their rent.

Shattil, Nebraskan general manager, said advertising revenue so far this year is down \$80,000 from last year. He said the newspaper expected less revenue, but it only budgeted for a \$20,000 loss.






