 Chas. W. Taylor reports himself as being well satisfied with the outlook for a successful year in the schools of Ohiowa. The school board is making more room for Charlie already.

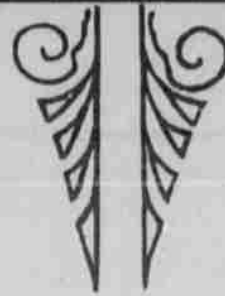
