

between Wisconsin and Yale. King is thoroughly conversant with eastern methods of coaching, he is in close touch with the Princeton coaching staff, and will have the benefit of any plays evolved by it. The material at Yale is not any better, if so good, as that at Wisconsin. O'Dea's punting will add 20 per cent. to the chances of his team, and his known ability to run back punts will lessen the efficiency of Yale's fullback's work.

"Michigan should be ranked next to Wisconsin. The Ann Arbor coaches played men on the second eleven last year who would have been on the varsity at Wisconsin or Chicago, and, in spite of the loss of a few excellent linemen, the abundance of material at Ann Arbor will make it possible for Ferbert and Henninger to fill the places of Cunningham, Bennett, Caley and Franz. The system of coaching at Michigan is not on such an excellent footing as that at Wisconsin, and the Wolverines have not had a first-class punter since Bloomington left. Michigan should play Cornell a close game, but, even if she wins, her victory will not be rated as high as that of Wisconsin over Yale, for Cornell has never been conceded by eastern critics as high rank as that given Yale.

"Chicago's prospects are darker this fall than they have been since 1894. Chicago plays October 28, Pennsylvania, probably the best team in the country. At the present time Stagg has not a first-class man in sight for center, both guards and one tackle. Pennsylvania, on the contrary, has these positions filled with old, experienced men, three of whom were last year on the all-American team. In the back field he has only one man, Kennedy, who can be classed with the backs of Pennsylvania's eleven.

"In admitting that Stagg is the best coach in the west, it is impossible to see how he can develop a team to cope with the experienced team of the Quakers in so short a time as three weeks, for the last half of the summer quarter has begun at the University of Chicago, and there is no exceptional material at present in the institution. If any promising men enter October 1, at the beginning of the fall term, Stagg will have only three weeks' time in which to develop the men so that they can be used in the Pennsylvania game, and even if the men are gifted with the foot ball instinct and their physical qualifications are all that can be desired it will yet be impossible for any coach to make these men as efficient as Hare and McCracken.

"If Chicago makes a respectable showing against the University of Pennsylvania the maroons will be doing well, but it should occasion little surprise if they should fail to score."
