The wheat crop is nearly all safely secured in the country.—(Sarp's Sentinel).

Report comes from the lower part of the valley that the crops are good and an abundant harvest is anticipated.—(Loup City News).

Reports from all parts of the country indicate that the wheat crop will average about 15 bushels to the acre.—(Pillmore County Bulletin).

Wild plum trees are loaded down with fruit, and an abundant plum harvest is expected.—(Seward Reporter).

Harvest is almost over, and threshing has already commenced. All the crop of wheat, so far as sold at 20 cents, is being sold at 18 cents, and the quantity will fall short of what it should be.—(Sutton County Times).

Wheat in the valley, which until recently looked excellent, will, notwithstanding the dry weather and ravages of the grasshoppers, average about 17 bushels to the acre. All the crop, that was fully matured, is being sold at 18 cents.—(Loup City News).

Reports from the northeast part of the county indicate a good fall crop of corn, some pieces are whole, and some are badly injured. The leaves are badly "chewed," but the silk had not yet appeared, the damage done is not so great.—(Johnny Register).

The farmers of Adams county are nearly through harvesting. The weather has been extremely hot, but otherwise the weather is exceedingly favorable. No storm has occurred, but the crops were damaged by too much wet weather.—(Hastings Journal).

During the past week most farmers in this locality have completed the harvest of their small grain. Generally, the crops look mature, but it is not so large a yield as usual, but is, so far as we have seen, superior in quality.—(Colfax Journal).

It is feared that the corn crop in this section is a failure. One week ago the corn crop promised an abundant harvest, but the grasshoppers have since then made sad havoc of it. It is feared that the crop can be expected to do well. The crop will be heavy no doubt.—(Clearwater Advocate).

The wheat crop throughout this county is represented by harvesters as being generally excellent. The grain in some late sown fields is somewhat shriveled by the continued dry weather, and occasionally a field was injured by grasshoppers and chinch bugs. These are the only exceptions, and farmers generally agree that the crop is unusually good.—(Nemaha County Advertiser).

We have now on exhibition at this office as of this year's crop, eleven feet in height, grown on Mr. Mollen's lot in this city. It was planted and has been tended by his sons, above, and has been raised here ever in the city. This corn is all about the same height and for a country where it has not rained for nearly two months, we challenge any State to equal it.—(Nebraska City Press).

The farmers are in the midst of harvesting now, and the yield is quite equal to the expectation. The wheat is turning out admirably, as also the barley, and the other crops are in excellent condition, and will yield heavily if nothing prevents from now until the middle of the month. The corn crop has been put into the ground and a much larger number of acres of wheat, but the corn, has, if possible, received better attention than ordinarily, and hence will yield a heavier crop.

We hear that in some portions of the county the grasshoppers have been very destructive. It is true, but we believe not to any very great extent taking the county together.—(Seward Advertiser).

We have taken a trip through our county, and find the wheat crop so badly injured by the late hot, dry weather, as we had a fair crop, our average wheat crop is larger than last year. Last year's crop was 110,000 bushels, and this year's crop is estimated at 120,000 bushels, and estimating 15 bushels to the acre on an average, our crops for this season will average 80,000 bushels, deducting 30,000 bushels for bread, and 20,000 for seed we still have 160,000 bushels for shipment, which will average about \$120,000, deducting \$25,000 for machinery would leave \$105,000 from the wheat crop alone for home circulation.

Our oat crop will be considerably better than last year. It is now nearly all out before the last raid of the grasshoppers, so that an average crop will be threshed. The late rains have saved the potato crop. While that part of the county not laid waste by the grasshoppers, which have settled down in patches of corn in the country will have an exceedingly good crop of wheat, so that the whole Dakota county can be thankful for the blessing of an average crop for the present year.—(Dodge Mail).

He got on by Bessy & Bessy, who have been supplying him with agricultural machinery for some years, and ordered a new half-ton tractor. Bessy & Bessy is one of those cheerful souls who never do anything by halves. A correspondent says of this farmer: "He is about 8 miles square and contains about 40,000 acres. Met Mr. Sullivan in the city yesterday found him full of pleasure and agreeable to many, ready to entertain any one who calls. A friend of Mr. W. B. Dix, chief clerk for the city, stated that he had seen the workings of the farm. Number of hands employed, about 600; mules and horses, 1,000; cattle, 500; number of acres in corn, 20,000; acres in small grain, 20,000; acres in tame grass, 4,000; miles of hedge, 300; head of hogs, 1,100; head of cattle, 800. Everything is ready for the market. He can sell all that he wants to raise in a bushel of grain on any section of his farm, also the cost each month of the most important crops. There is a resident doctor, Blair, who attends to the sick. According to the report of a friend, he stated that 11 cents per bushel in ordinary seasons will put corn in the crib, and 20 cents per day will board hands. The bill of fare is better than that of most hotels. He has a mess beef, fresh corn, flour, bread, and all the necessaries of life. Dried apples, vinegar, molasses, lard, spices, eggs, fresh vegetables, etc., cost 20 cents per bushel. Round Mr. Sullivan's property, Mr. Miner, the general manager and a very pleasant gentleman. A large stock of goods is kept on hand, which the men can buy at a net cost. It is said to be, by competent judges, the best land most elevated in the State, and it is a fact that there is now in crib on the farm, 450,000 bushels of corn, waiting the completion of the elevator to be shelled and put into the market.
