CLOVER IS KNOWN IN THE HEALTHY burg plaza, and farmers in the vicinity are getting ready to cut hay. The San Jose fruit-packing establishments are making extensive arrangements for an increased business this year.

A NEW WOOLEN MILL is about to be erected in Oakland at an expense of \$100,000. It will be operated exclusively by white labor.

A COLUSA MAN had some 2,000 sheep in the trough, and the herder, neglecting to watch them, until surrounded by water, some 1,500 head were drowned. Men were sent out to work skinning those that were drowned, and several hundred pelts were saved.

EUREKA, Humboldt county, is exercised over the discovery of a wonderful find of mammoth proportions, about three hours ride from Garberville. The mouth of the cave is about seven hundred feet above the bed of the South Fork, on the west side, and the precipitous east side of Bear Butte.

THE AMERICAN FORK canyon road is now open to seventeen miles, almost as far as Forest City. The mines near the canyon are promising well and so much for the investor as to be at present.

THE CARSON MINT commenced active work last Monday. Its force of employees number sixty-eight—fifty men and twelve women. The mint has a sufficient supply of bullion on hand to insure continuous work for two months, and more is arriving daily in enormous amounts.

THE LARGEST CANYON IN BRECKENRIDGE is six miles in diameter, having a neat floor and floats the American flag on a survey. Spring grain is looking well, and what fall sowing was done before winter set in, is doing well.

THE DENVER POLICE recently made a systematic raid on the opium dens. There are ten of them which are kept by Chinamen and are patronized by American men and women. During the past year two tons of opium, valued at \$90,000, were smoked in these places.
