CUT HIS THROAT.

St. Louis, November 28. About half past 8 o'clock yesterday Coroner Jacobs received a telephone communication from Fort Omaha, calling him out there to hold an inquest on the body of a suicide.

The unfortunate man who ended his life voluntarily was one L. B. Denbary, a carpenter who has for several years past worked for the government heretofore. He was fifty-eight years of age and large and powerfully built, and so far as known not of extremely bad habits.

For four or five years past he has stopped off and on at Henry Bechtel's hotel, the Fort Omaha House, near the barracks, and there it was that he ended his life in a horrible manner. Those who have worked with him say he drank but little but he was not composed at times and Sunday he appeared a little off, though he was drinking but lightly. He had been in jail here once for insanity. At 7:30 or 8 o'clock Sunday when he was missed from the house, one felt a particular anxiety as to his whereabouts and at breakfast yesterday he was still absent.

About 8 o'clock William Hall, the bartender, went to one of the out-houses, and found the door fastened on the inside. He did not force an entrance then, but later, when he had tried the door several times, went around and passed through an aperture, where a board had been broken off some time before.

A horrible sight met his gaze. The old man lay there, his throat cut from ear to ear, surrounded by a pool of his own blood. A telephone message was at once sent to Coroner Jacobs and the body left in the position in which it was found until his arrival. An inquest was held at which the following jury was empaneled: John A. Alexander, Chas. Coll, Dennis Purcell, Wm. Reynolds, Jacob Webber and Wm. Roach.

The only witnesses examined were Henry Bechtel, Wm. Hall and Chas. Miller. The verdict was in accordance with the facts, that the deceased had come to his death at his own hands by cutting his throat with a pocket knife. The deceased had no effects, with the exception of an old coat, with some tools of small value in it, and he owed seven or eight dollars on board to Mr. Bechtel. Although he has some relations in the east, their address is not known, and he will probably be buried by the county.

The body was brought down and laid out at Undertaker Jacobs' rooms, making three bodies there at one time. The pocket knife had done its deadly work well, as was attested by the horrible gash extending clear across the throat, and the jugular vein had been completely severed, and the clothing and boots were saturated with blood. The man undoubtedly committed the act while laboring under temporary aberration of mind.
