It had taken root in the sod without having been planted, and as we passed by there stood in patches along the right-of-way fully developed oats and barley and stalks of corn that measured at least four feet in height, with full-sized ears upon them.

To the Editor of the Bee. An article appeared in THE BEE yesterday with the above heading, which has induced me to pen the following remarks:

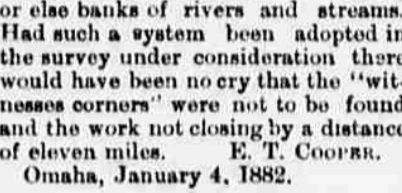
