POLITICAL NOTES. Mr. Jerome Eddy, of Pitts, Mich., will probably be the democratic candidate for governor of that state. Arkansas democrats assert that Breckinridge, their candidate for congressional election, will run 10,000 ahead of his ticket.

The democratic leaders in Tennessee will hold a state convention in Nashville, July 11, and the Memphis Appeal, though strongly supporting the regular ticket, concedes that they will poll from 100,000 to 200,000 in case they just candidates into the field.

It appears to be settled that Representative Converse will be sent back to congress from the Cincinnatus Ohio, district. John C. Thompson declares that he is not a candidate, and the only other possible rival are E. J. Hinnman and Judge Engle. The latter withdrew from the race some time ago.

It is reported that Channey I. Filley, chairman of the state republican committee of Missouri, is in favor of making no republican nominations, but of supporting the greenback candidates in the hope of thus breaking down the republican supremacy. As the republican party for years at the last general election received 153,636 votes, and the greenback candidate only 35,338, this looks a good deal like a proposition that will not carry the dog.
