Share speculation opened irregular, the chances from yesterday's closing figures being only fractional except for St. Paul, Minneapolis & Manitoba, which was 2 per cent higher. During early trade the market was very dull, but an advance of 2 per cent took place in St. Paul, Minneapolis & Manitoba, 1 per cent in Minneapolis & St. Louis, and a fraction in the remainder of the list. Subsequently a decline followed ranging from 1 to 2 per cent--St. Paul, Minneapolis & Manitoba and New York; Chicago & St. Louis being the most conspicuous. The market closed strong, showing an advance on the day's transactions of 1½ per cent--the latter St. Paul, Minneapolis & Manitoba, Hamtramck & St. Joe preferred, however, is 2 per cent lower.
