The stock market was feverish throughout the day and mainly weak. Prices at the close were generally 1/2@24 point below the closing figures yesterday—the latter Louisville & N. W. Hi. It appears that among other influences due to rising foreign exchange is the fact J. W. Seligman have been drawing on London and Paris a sufficient amount to yield between \$5,000,000 and \$6,000,000, which they have paid on account of the Panama canal company (De Leeser's scheme) to stockholders of the Panama railroad company, who, a long time ago entered into an agreement to sell their stock to the Canal company.
