The United States mint in this city has just received over two tons of three-cent silver pieces which by act of congress have been withheld from the national coinage. This is, however, only about one-fifth of the quantity of these small coins which are to be brought here from the various sub-treasuries in the country, there having already been retrenched more than ten tons. These three-cent pieces now in the mint would fill three large wagons. They are to be returned into circulation, as the three-cent nickel pieces are to take the place of the old silver three-cent coins.
