Special Dispatch to The Bee. NEW YORK, November 17. MONEY.—3 1/2 per cent, closed offered at 3 per cent.

Prime Mercantile Paper—6 1/2 per cent. Sterling Exchange—Steady; Bankers' bills, 34/16; demand, 34/16.

Dry goods imports for the week \$1,881,600.

Government was 1/2 per cent higher for extended 3's; 1/4 for 3's and unchanged for 4's and 4 1/2's.

Share speculation opened weak and prices were a fraction lower than at yesterday's close.

The market continued weak in early dealings and under the lead of Delaware, Lackawanna & Western and Oregon & Transcontinental fell off 1/16 per cent.

But at 11 o'clock an advance from 1/16 to 1/8 per cent took place, in which Northern Pacific common and preferred, Louisville & Nashville and Union Pacific were most conspicuous.

The market then became heavy, and about midday Reading sold down 1/16 per cent, Denver & Rio Grande 1/8 per cent, St. Paul 1/8 per cent and the remainder of the list 1/16 per cent.

In final dealings Union Pacific common advanced to 1/16 and preferred to 9/16, their highest price during the day.

The market closed feverish and irregular with changes from yesterday's closing prices irregular, but generally 1/16 to 1/8 per cent lower, Richmond & West Point, Delaware, Lackawanna & Western, Reading and Texas Pacific being prominent in the decline, while Oregon & Transcontinental was 1/8 per cent, Northern Pacific 2/8 per cent, and common 1 per cent higher.

The day as a whole has been very irregular and unsettled, with Northern Pacific and Oregon & Transcontinental strong features.
