Nearly a Million Dollars of Property Destroyed in the Town. Several Thousand of Workmen Thrown Out of Work and Rendered Destitute.

Manufacturers on Fire. COHOES, N. Y., January 4.—The rolling mills of Morrison, Colwell & Page are burning.

LATER TELEGRAMS. COHOES, January 6.—The fire is now under control. Morrison Colwell & Page's rolling mills, O'Brien & Powers' knitting mills, and the Patrick Gogarty paper mills are totally destroyed.

THE ORIGIN OF THE FIRE. COHOES, January 6.—The fire originated in the wheel pit of the rolling mill. Work was suspended last Friday for repairs and was to be resumed this morning.
