NEW YORK, January 12. Money—On call loaned down from 4½ to 3 per cent, and closed offered at 3 per cent. Prime Mercantile Paper—5½@6 per cent. Sterling Exchange—Bankers' bills steady at \$4.81; demand, \$4.83. Dry goods imports for the week, \$3,047,000.

Governments were generally weak.

Railroad bonds were moderately active, but irregular.

The stock market was extremely dull all day, but closed steady, the majority of active stocks being a fraction higher than at the close yesterday. Among the specialties were Memphis & Charleston, which declined from 52½ to 49 regular and 48 seller, and Richmond & Danville, which declined from 53½ to 49. This has been the smallest day's business for a year past.

The Post says: "It is a fair presumption that the diminishing business is as much due to the increasing conservatism of the bears as of the bulls. Everything seems to be waiting for further developments, and the market is getting into a temper in which less important circumstances than heretofore would cause an important movement."
