THE MINISTRY.

Ministers Discussing the Subject of "Calls" to Preach.

WEDNESDAY 11:20 A. M. FREMONT, November 1. Dr. Webb, of Grand Island, had sent his paper on a call to the ministry, not being able to be present and it was read by Rev. G. W. Read of Gibbon.

Dr. Stone: God duplicates His calls—one to the minister and another to hearers, as a modification of which, however, he said Robert Hall was not encouraging at first.

Rev. Chaffee: What is the call—not from whom or the evidence of it but what is itself?

Rev. Hutton: Paul tells what it is—he must be of good report as the first item, notes of Dr. Barnes being referred to on that subject.

Rev. Haggood, of David City: Dr. Robinson of Rhode Island teaches the same as Barnes' notes.

Rev. Osborn: Every man of good report is not called. Rev. Rockwood favored the paper as read.

Rev. J. M. Taggart: If a man preaches and sinners are converted, it is evidence of his call.

Rev. Holmes of Blair: Councils should be cautious in ordaining preachers.

Rev. Chaffee: The woe spoken of rests as much upon what is preached as upon the preacher—if I preach not the gospel, I am not doing my duty.

Rev. J. M. Price, of the Morgan Park school of Chicago, spoke of the work of Prof. Harper, teacher of Hebrew, teaching by correspondence.

Dr. Stone read a paper on the philosophy of prayer. First, What it is, and second some of its operations. Objections to prayer because God is invisible are as weak as objections to telegraph or telephone, or even letter writing, because the parties are out of sight.

Rev. G. W. Read, of Gibbon, read a paper on the Baptism of the Holy Spirit—its nature, manifestation and perpetuity. Critics were offered by Rev. Bedell, Dr. Stone, Dr. Smith, of the Chicago Standard, and Rev. J. A. Guild, of Ashland.

Programme for the ensuing year: A resolution discouraging divorce and marriage other than is justified by the New Testament, was passed by a rising vote; not to extend clerical courtesy to the same.

Question Box brought out many good suggestions from Dr. Stone. Adjoined.

Wednesday evening—At 7 o'clock Rev. G. W. Read, President of the Sunday School convention opened the exercises, addressing a large congregation for a short time upon Sunday school work.

Rev. J. W. Osborn, Sunday school missionary, led a responsive praise service, after which Rev. F. Thearle, of Chicago, delighted the audience with an excellent address upon Sunday school work as connected with the work of the Publication Society.

He gave Boston Smith's definition of the Sunday school, the Bible study and service of the church. One Sunday school had no small children, saying they had none—they were used to go and bring in somebody else's children—must have small children or lose the hope and promise. The old are hardest to keep in Sunday school—many they know so little they are ashamed to be there. The superintendent must not be expected to be so much more than a man and so much less than an angel. The assistant superintendent must have a good deal of shaking-hand religion, and the secretary should not be kept more than two years from the study of the book for how long? The Bible should early take the place of lesson leaves. The International lesson leaves are not the best thing, but are commended because we can do better. Adjoined.
