NOTES OF THE FLOOD.

The Hartford City Coal and Salt company estimate their loss at \$100,000; the Syracuse Coal and Salt company nearly as much. At the town of Racine 150 houses have been moved from their foundations and many have floated away.

The relief committee of Philadelphia have telegraphed \$500 each to Portsmouth and Athens, and \$1000 to Gallipolis. The people of Dayton have petitioned the legislature to appropriate \$500,000 for the flood sufferers.
