The total sales of Lackawanna were 174,450. The general market was much disturbed by the movement in Lackawanna. Early in the day prices rose 1/2 to 2 per cent., the latter Union Pacific, which sold up to 1 1/2.

After midday a weaker feeling set in, and there was a decline of 1/4 to 1 per cent. In the afternoon there was a recovery, on reports from the west that Colorado rates had been restored. Northwestern sold up to 1 1/2, St. Paul to 1 1/2, Rock Island to 1 1/2, Northern Pacific to 1 1/2, all the highest prices of the day. The market closed strong as compared with Saturday's closing. Union Pacific is 2 1/2 per cent. higher, Northwestern 1 1/2, St. Paul 1 1/2, Rock Island 1 1/2, Northern Pacific preferred 1 1/2, Chicago, Burlington and Quincy 3/4. The St. Paul & Omaha company sold \$1,100,000 of its 6 per cent. bonds to H. B. Hollis & Co., the highest bidder. The company is authorized to sell bonds.
