MAKING CHEAP JEWELRY. The Modern Operands of the Makers of Finback Ornaments

"Plated jewelry is far more serviceable than rolled gold jewelry," said Mr. Chas. Fass. "Rolled plate is made by sweating down the gold on the metal.

"Red gold, as you call it, is simply an alloy of gold and copper; the parts can be just the same as in an alloy of gold and silver--just so much as is necessary to harden gold to a given point.

"Alloy is a combination of metals with each other, except when mercury is a constituent, in which case the combination is called an amalgam; thus, bronze is an alloy of copper and tin, brass and alloy of copper and zinc, etc.

"An amalgam of tin and mercury is used for looking-glasses; gold amalgamates the most readily of all metals with quicksilver. When in a state of fusion it very easily and very intimately combines with silver, and when mixed with tin also runs into a mass with iron.

"In a little room as closely shut off from the rest of the factory as is usually the workshop of a photographer from the rest of his establishment, was a Smoed battery in full operation. In several of the jars were small, thin pieces of yellowish red metal, attached to a small wire hanging from the highest of two rods running from the battery.

"That metal and head member of the firm, 'is all prepared by us. The gold is purchased in square blocks 2 inches long, 1 1/2 inches wide and 1/4 inches thick. It is rolled down, and then alloyed for 10, 12, 14, 16 or 18 carats. From 10 to 16 carats is the most common, and 14 is the preferable.

"The brass comes to us in straight 'low rods. It is then twisted in coil by an ordinary writ and then cut in 1/4 inch rings. The article is first put in to be thoroughly cleaned. It is the hang in the jars on the lower rod, the lead sheet in the upper rod, because their positions were transposed the brass would be washed on the gold. The bracelet is taken out and occasionally treated with nitric acid. When it resists the action of the acid, or, in other words, does not turn black, it is taken out of the jar and put in sawdust to dry, after which it is burnished and passed up to the finishers, who add some neat-looking trifles to the ring to finish it off, such as a small gold-padlock or a pretty little bird in Roman gold or silver.

"How much gold is used in one jar? "About three grains a minute; but sometimes the battery will work quicker and plate twice as much as it will at other times.

"How many bracelets will one ounce of gold plate? "One hundred and fifty pairs." The casting of the ornaments used on jewelry, such as birds, flowers, leaves, etc., is a very important branch of a factory. Everything is done by steam. The burnishing is done exclusively by women.

The joints for bracelets are the most delicate. The cutting of the smallest hook or tiniest trimming is done on what is known as a watchmaker's wheel, a costly piece of tool--\$700 lowest price--which can be used to cut a large bar of metal or to turn out the most delicate screw.

The New York Sun (dem.) devotes a long article to the 'political arithmetic' of the campaign in New York, going over carefully all the chances of Cleveland and Blaine carrying the state.

There is a rebellion against Blaine and who are the rebels? Is there rebellion conducted by the stalwarts, of whom Arthur and Folger are the chiefs? Do they spring from a desire for vengeance for the defeat of Folger? No, it does not; it is conducted by an altogether different faction. Curiously enough, the present republican rebels who will not have any thing to do with Mr. Blaine would seem to be made up chiefly from the free-trading wing of the republican party.

The centers of their movement are in Boston New Haven, and New York. They are political economists rather than politicians, and as to their number, there is no present means of telling how great it may be.

The election of this fall will unquestionably bring on a very large proportion of the whole number of the voters. In the eight years between the election of 1876, when Seymour and Grant obtained together 850,000 votes, and that of 1878, when Hayes and Tilden aggregated 1,011,000, and there was an increase of 100,000 in the voting force of the state. It is not an extravagant estimate that in the eight years that have since elapsed the increase has been sufficient to make the voting force at the polls in November deliver the mighty number of 1,260,000 ballots.
