## FINANCIAL

NEW YORK, August 11.—Money—Easy; 1½%; closed offered 1.

Prime Mercantile paper—5½@6%.

Sterling bills—Dull; 4 ½%; demand 4 ¼%.

Stocks—The market opened heavy and depressed. On the announcement of the suspension of the Wall street bank there was a sharp pressure to sell for both accounts; prices soon declined 1½%. Subsequently a rally of 1½% occurred on the official reports that the depositors of the bank would be paid in full, and that there would be something left for the shareholders. Later there was a renewed weakness, and many shares touched the lowest figures of the day. After 2 p. m., Missouri Pacific developed strength, and this was the means of turning the market for the better. In the final dealings a weaker tone set in and the recovery partially lost. The market closed irregular. Compared with Saturday's closing prices are 1½% lower, except for Missouri Pacific, Reading and Jersey Central, which were 1½% higher.
